text CHURCH SMK to 70500 to donate £5 (eg for the offertory collection). Your £5 donation will come to St Mary's via the diocese who have set up this facility for us. The Parish will receive 96% of your £5 donation. The money will come from your mobile network account. You only pay a donation if you receive a reply message back. The reply message gives you the opportunity to Gift Aid your donation if you are a UK tax payer. Some mobile phone accounts have text donations blocked on them because they are business phones or they are pre-pay phones with insufficient credit. You may (depending on network) have to pay to send a "standard rate" message which should cost about 10p. Always get the bill payers permission.
