I know parishioners are keeping in contact and supporting each other in many different ways. As part of this, please do all you can to help others to get set up with internet access so they can join us for our livestream celebrations of Sunday Mass, on computer, tablets, smart phone or smart tv, so we can continue to celebrate Mass together as a parish.

TEXT GIVING

Since we're not currently taking an offertory collection at Mass, text CHURCH SMK to 70500 to donate £5 (eg for the offertory collection). Your £5 donation will come to St Mary's via the diocese who have set up this facility for us. The Parish will receive 96% of your £5 donation. The money will come from your mobile network account. You only pay a donation if you receive a reply message back. The reply message gives you the opportunity to Gift Aid your donation if you are a UK tax payer. Some mobile phone accounts have text donations blocked on them because they are business phones or they are pre-pay phones with insufficient credit. You may (depending on network) have to pay to send a "standard rate" message which should cost about 10p. Always get the bill payers permission.
