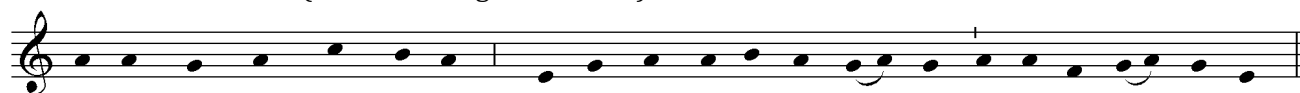

FIR TREE Following a recent tree survey, it is clear the fir tree in the garden has become unmanageable and its root system is now destroying the path. This is now a significant safety issue as well as a damage issue, as confirmed by our Health and Safety Officer. The surveyor has explained to us that there is no satisfactory pruning or pollarding solution to this type of tree and that the only alternative is for it to be felled. Unfortunately this is not going to be a cheap operation for a tree this size, as ideally it would have been tackled at an earlier stage.
