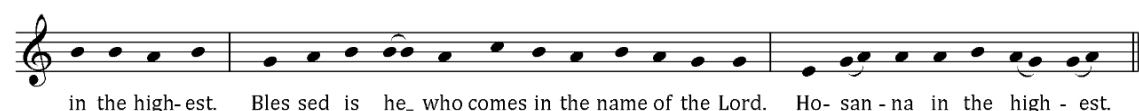

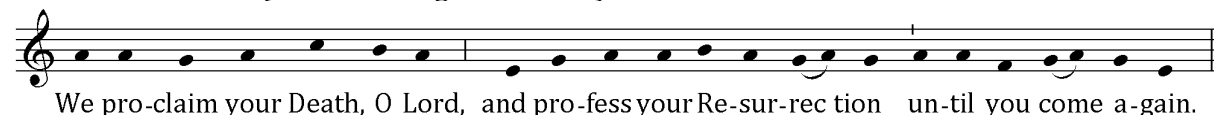

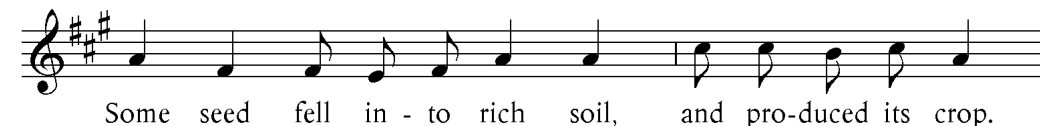

CHRISTIAN - MUSLIM WITNESS: The Christian Muslim Forum, Churches Together in England and Leeds Church Institute are collaborating to arrange an event at Wheeler Hall (adjacent to the Cathedral in Leeds) on Tuesday, 9 September on: "Invitation to Faith Exploring Christian approaches to mission, Muslim approaches to Dawah and the possibility of shared witness." Speakers include Nuzhat Ali (Islamic Society of Britain) and Charles Dobbin MBE (Anglican priest in North Leeds), Qari Asim MBE (Imam in North Leeds) and Liz Firth (Diocese of Leeds).
