

**RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION** On Corpus Christi we rehearsed some practical guidelines about receiving communion. Coming forward in two lines coming forward for Holy Communion. Standing side by side to receive the host. (No need to stand back while the person next to you receives the host.) If you're receiving on the hand, keep hand flat and steady while the priest places the host on your hand. Receiving the chalice: one hand under the base is best and most secure.
