

**THE OLD SCHOOL (CHURCH HALL) PROJECT.** We have received planning permission for our proposed works and AAT has granted us a new loan facility as well as authority to proceed. We plan to start work on site 29 June with completion by 5 Sept 2015. The scheme was successfully tendered and we have confidence in the preferred contractor. The tender sums were above our previous estimates and we have given careful consideration as to whether to proceed or not. It was a difficult decision but on balance we know that the work needs doing if we wish the Parish to have good quality and usable facilities. We believe that the majority of the Parish are supportive of the improvement works and associated fundraising. The additional cost will result in 2 extra years of affordable loan repayments compared with the original estimates. Combining The Old School renovation + improvement project and the, separate, Church improvement + redecoration project we estimate a total new loan of £180,000 will be required, payable over 9 years. To put this in context we recently paid off the previous £350,000 loan in 13 years.

**PROCLAIM '15:** We began in Lent this year to explore what it might mean for us to become a missionary parish. This is part of a nationwide initiative called Proclaim 15, leading up to a national evangelisation conference in Birmingham Saturday 11th July 2015. We'll be having a Holy Hour at St Mary's on the Friday evening 10th July at 7.00pm beginning with Mass. The prayer we've been using in recent weeks at Sunday Mass to conclude our bidding prayers is part of the Proclaim '15 initiative and is being used throughout the Catholic Church in England and Wales leading up to 11th July.
