CHURCH REFURBISHMENT UPDATE: We remain on target for Spring 2017. We presented our scheme to the Arts, Architecture and Heritage committee and they encouraged us to be more bold with our design. We return to AAH in September followed by final submission and planning approval from the Historic Church Committee in November. A firm of surveyors and conservation experts have been engaged as Project Managers. We are receiving design and colour advice from a professional designer.
