**ST JOHN'S CAR PARK** St John's very kindly allow us to use their car park during Sat 6pm and Sun 5pm Masses, but not during our Sun 10am Mass. They have their own service at this time. Parking options: Tentergate, Stockwell Road (shortly before it joins Boroughbridge Road) and, normally on Boroughbridge Road. However, 22 July – 13 September, road works are planned on Boroughbridge Road between Byards Park and Scriven Road. There is disc parking (2hrs) on the High Street, Station Road and Kirkgate. Conyngham Park charges 90p for 1hr and £1.80 for 2hrs. Other than that people could perhaps ask other parishioners where they park? If walking or cycling is a possibility for you that's another option you could consider.
