Dear People of St Mary's and online visitors to our parish

After three weeks of recorded Sunday Masses from St Mary's we have now, as of this Easter Sunday, launched 'livestream mass' from St Mary's. This means that from this Sunday, and going forward, you can join us all online each Sunday in 'real time' for the celebration of the Mass, and at your usual mass time. Simply click on the new link at the top of the homepage, and you'll find it there. You'll see the link is called: New (: ) Livestreams and Recordings.

Live streamed from St Mary's at Saturday 6pm (Easter Vigil) and Sunday 10am and Sunday 5pm. So you can join me in the celebration from your homes in 'real time'. Bishop Marcus plans to celebrate Easter Day Mass in the Cathedral at 11:00am. See the link on the parish website called Mass live streamed from the Cathedral.
