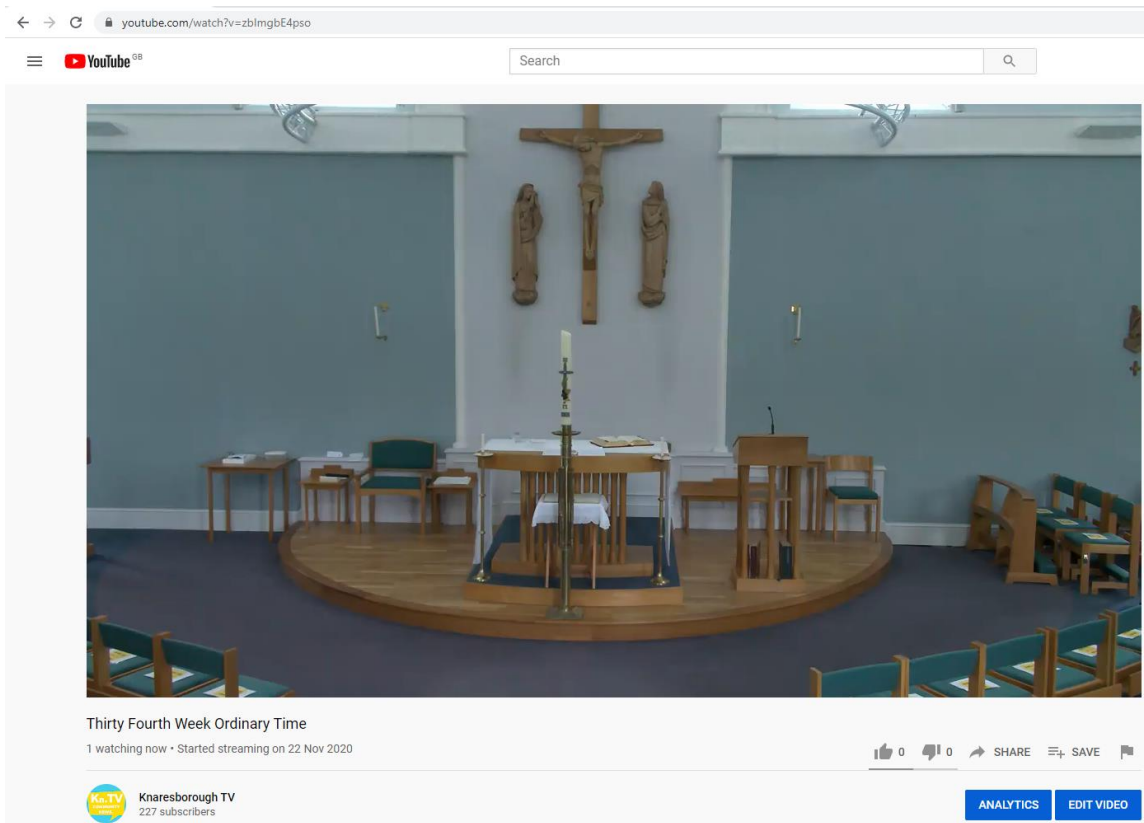


Livestream field of vision



This celebration of mass is being livestreamed, so that people with an online connection can celebrate mass with us remotely.

This enables, in particular, parishioners to celebrate mass with us who cannot get to church. This could be for a variety of reasons, for example being housebound, being unwell or shielding, away on work commitments, away on holiday.

It also enables parishioners to choose to celebrate mass by livestream as a safe way of celebrating mass during a pandemic that reduces the risk of viral transmission to zero.

It also allows people from anywhere in the world with an internet connection to celebrate mass with us.

The image above shows the field of vision for the livestream. The camera is fixed in the door alcove of the Bond End exit. The camera is static and, during mass, the zoom is fixed. The field of vision is centred on the sanctuary as shown, extending to either side as far as the stations of the cross, approximately. The camera is approximately seven feet above the floor, a little above head height.
